Horse Show Rules and Descriptions

Age Determination: Age of exhibitor (rider) as of Jan. 1, 2010, determines eligibility for the year.

Tot Leadline: Rider must be age 6 or under; may not enter any other under saddle classes. The horse or pony must be lead by an adult or experienced handler.

Walk Only: Rider can be of any age. An experienced handler may accompany the rider and walk at their side, but may not lead the horse. If there is cause for the handler to assist the rider they may do so without the rider being disqualified. Walk Only riders may not enter any other under saddle classes. It is okay to enter halter classes.

Beginner: Riders in their first year of showing, regardless of age. May enter Walk/Trot or Walk/Jog only may not enter any other under saddle classes. It is okay to enter halter classes.

Open Classes; Open to all riders regardless of age

Pony/Mini Classes: Pony/Mini must be 14.2 hands or under. Ponies/Minis may only enter classes specifying "pony" as long as the rider meets age requirements.

Gaited Horse: Open to all Non-Trotting breed horses. Riders of all ages can show in this division.

Color Halter: Open to all mares, stallions/geldings of any age. Horse must possess Pinto, Paint, Appaloosa, Palomino, or Buckskin color.

Stallions: Anyone showing/handling/riding a stallion must be at least 18 years old.

Trail Classes: May be shown in English or Western tack. Riders will be asked to maneuver over and through obstacles such as a bridge, poles, cones and a gate. Pivots and side pass work may be required. Riders may also be asked to carry a rain coat from one obstacle to another. Pattern will be posted.

Patterns: If a class has a pattern, it will be posted near the entry gate. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know and follow the pattern.

Proper Attire: All classes require proper attire, unless the judge specifically waives coat requirements. The jumpers must wear boots and an ASTM-approved helmet; this requirement cannot be waived by the judge.

Daily High Point Awards: To qualify for the daily Division Point Championship/Reserve Champion Awards, the same horse/rider combination must compete in classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor scoring highest in the equitation class wins.

Judging: The Judge's decision is final! Anyone with a question for the judge will notify the show chairman who will arrange a short meeting with the judge during lunch, a break or at the end of the show.

General Information:

Coggins Required: A negative original Coggins, dated within the last 12 months, must be presented to the show manager upon registration.

Prohibited Items: Absolutely no alcohol or illegal drugs will be allowed on show grounds. You will be asked to leave immediately if this rule is violated.

Pets: All pets must be kept on a leash. Pets are not allowed inside the concession/snack bar.

Year End High Point Requirements:

High-Point Fee: a one time \$20 per horse/rider combination fee is required in order to be eligible for year end awards. Points will not be awarded until this fee has been paid to the show secretary before the show begins.

Point Accumulation: Points are awarded to the same class/horse/rider combination for the entire year. An exhibitor must show in at least five (5) of the seven (7) shows of the year to be eligible for year end awards. Additionally, each exhibitor must show in at least two (2) Spring and two (2) Fall points shows.

Show Dates: Points Show dates are: Mar. 6, 2010; April 3, 2010; May 8, 2010; June 5, 2010; Sep. 4, 2010; Oct. 2, 2010; and Nov. 6, 2010. Open Show dates are: Feb 6, 2010 and Aug. 7, 2010.
